

B-G Wall of Distinction



I. Purpose

The Bainbridge-Guilford Central School Wall of Distinction was established to:

- Honor graduates or those who served Bainbridge Central School District, Guilford Central School District, or B-G Central School District through a life of honor, recognition, and distinction.
- Identify role models for the current students of B-G.
- Make a connection to the district's history for the current students and graduates.
- Provide public awareness of the successes of B-G graduates and those who have served the district.

II. Location

• Plaques honoring each of the inductees will be displayed on a wall near the athletic entrance lobby in the B-G Jr.- Sr. High School Building. The district's website will be used to publicize the B-G Wall of Distinction.

III. Criteria for Selection

- Nominees for the B-G Wall of Distinction must have either graduated a minimum of ten years ago or served for at least ten years at Bainbridge Central School District, Guilford Central School District, and/or B-G Central School District.
- Posthumous nomination will be accepted.
- To be eligible for nomination, the individual must have demonstrated noteworthy or outstanding achievement in any of the following categories:
 - A. Academic / Professional Achievements
 - B. Leadership
 - C. Community Service / Civic Involvement
 - D. Athletic Achievements
 - E. Achievements in the Arts
 - F. Armed Services

IV. Timeline for Selection and Induction


- The initial induction ceremony will be held in conjunction with, and as a part of the B-G Alumni Association's All Classes Reunion in July 2025.
- Each year the Wall of Distinction Committee will solicit nominations through the B-G Alumni Association's newsletter, Blue and White, and the district website for individuals to be considered for induction.
- Nominations will be sent to the Wall of Distinction Committee.
- Timeline
 - **March 2024-** Announcement of criteria and nomination process will be publicized.
 - April 1, 2024 September 30, 2024 Nominations received during this time will be accepted and reviewed. Applications received after September 30 will be reviewed the following year.
 - October 2024 December 2024- The Wall of Distinction Committee reviews nominations and information is verified. The committee will meet to vote on nominees for induction and selected recipients will be notified.
 - March 2025 Names of inductees will be announced through the district website, B-G Alumni Association's newsletter, and social media.
 - July 2025 All Classes Reunion Induction Ceremony

V. Selection Process

Nominees will be selected for the Wall of Distinction annually. All nominees eligible for induction will have an equal opportunity to be selected. All non-selected nominations will remain on file for a period of five years. After five years the individual can be re-nominated.

VI. Committee Membership

The Wall of Distinction Committee will consist of 6-10 members. The members will include a mix of current school employees, former employees, alumni, and residents of the district.
